Prices Explained & F.A.Q.

This should hopefully clarify any questions you have about booking, if not then please PM Tanner on the Forum with your question. All bookings detailed on this form need to be made and payment reach us on or by the 13th June 2008.

FAMILY TICKET

The Family Ticket is for any 2 adults (18 and over) and either 3 or 4 minors aged 11 – 17.

The price is the same for 3 or 4 minors but if you are bringing more than 4, please contact Tanner on the forum to negotiate a price.

Under 11's are free to attend with an adult.

If 2 adults are bringing 2 minors, you should use the Adult & Child ticket twice, not the family ticket.

This ticket includes a discount and no further discounts (such as Student or Unemployed discounts) can be applied to this ticket.

ADULT & CHILD

A discounted ticket for one adult (18 and over) and 1 minor aged 11 – 17.

Under 11's are free to attend with an adult.

If 2 adults are bringing 2 minors, you should use the Adult & Child ticket twice.

This ticket includes a discount and no further discounts (such as Student or Unemployed discounts) can be applied to this ticket.

PRE-BOOK STANDARD

The standard price for one player aged 11 or over is £45.

Student or Unemployed discount of £5 can be applied to this ticket if applicable.

To qualify for this price payment in full must be received on or before the date above.

GROUP BOOKING

Use this ticket when one person is paying for 8 or more players. The players do not need to all be members of the same IC group or faction (Death Sect Priests, Grig, Villagers etc).

Payments do have to be sent together, preferably in 1 cheque or payment.

Payment needs to be sent in full for each player.

Student or Unemployed discount of £5 can be applied to this ticket if applicable. An additional discount of £2.50 applies to all players in the group.

It is recommended for simplicity that one event at a time is paid for in this manor, but some or all players can pay for multiple events and still claim the discount.

Example.

10 players get together and hand over money to 1 player who sends their bookings and payments. 5 players are students or unemployed and 5 are working. The total sent for all 10 players is £400.

STUDENT/UNEMPLOYED DISCOUNT

Student discount applies to under 16's and anyone with a valid student ID card or other proof of Student status.

Unemployed discount applies to any Non-Student out of work when booking.

Proof of status is required to be produced on the gate.

Doesn't apply on certain tickets.

RED SHIRT TICKET

There are a limited number of Red Shirt Tickets available. Red Shirts are a kind of Monster Squad but you get to play your own character when not needed. If you wish to come as a Red Shirt you must make yourself available to play parts as and when needed by the Refs.

No further discounts apply to the Red Shirt ticket price. Please check places are available before booking.

RETURNS POLICY

If you need to cancel a booking, we would prefer to hold any moneys over for future events (including Raider's Bluff events held at Candleston in Wales) but they can be returned if requested. A handling fee of £5 or less per player may be required unless the event is cancelled. Please write to the booking address or PM Tanner on the forum to cancel a booking.

F.A.Q.

Q) What's the plot about at Trinity?

A) As with Raiders Bluff (our other event held at Candleston), the aim is to survive and thrive in a hostile world. You should be trying to make your group/faction the strongest, best, etc. group around. There will also be many sub plots being run over the weekend.

Q) Is this a one-off event?

A) Raiders Bluff will remain our priority and focus at Cataclysm. However, if there is enough interest to keep both events going, Trinity will be back in 2009 with at least one event, perhaps two.

Q) So what's all this talk of "Red Shirts"?

A) No we're not going all Sci Fi, though Star Trek is certainly where the name comes from. A Red Shirt is a sort of NPC. They are minor members of a player group, usually in the background. Each player group/faction has a maximum number of Red Shirts available to them. 4 or more players are allowed to pay a minimum amount and come along and play a Red Shirt. Refs and Crew may also be playing Red Shirts from time to time.

Q) If I'm playing a Red Shirt do I choose my character?

A) Yes and no. As a Red Shirt you are to make yourself available to the Refs to play bit parts as and when required. However, when not needed you can choose your own character and stick with it until needed elsewhere. It's always possible that you bring that Red Shirt character back at a future event as a full blown character.

Q) But why are they called Red Shirts?

A) The thing about Red Shirts is, they are usually not quite as strong as normal characters. Think your group is heading into an ambush? Send a Red Shirt up front (they're expendable). Looking to pick off one of the enemy as they straggle behind the rest? Try and target a Red Shirt (he looks an easy target). There is likely to be a high mortality rate amongst Red Shirts.

Q) So Red Shirts are a monster squad?

A) Although they will be playing bit parts possibly including monsters, they also are available to play things like undead raised by the players (so you don't have to persuade a mate to put his character on hold and paint himself up), but because they get to play permanent characters, they are a lot more than a "monster squad".
