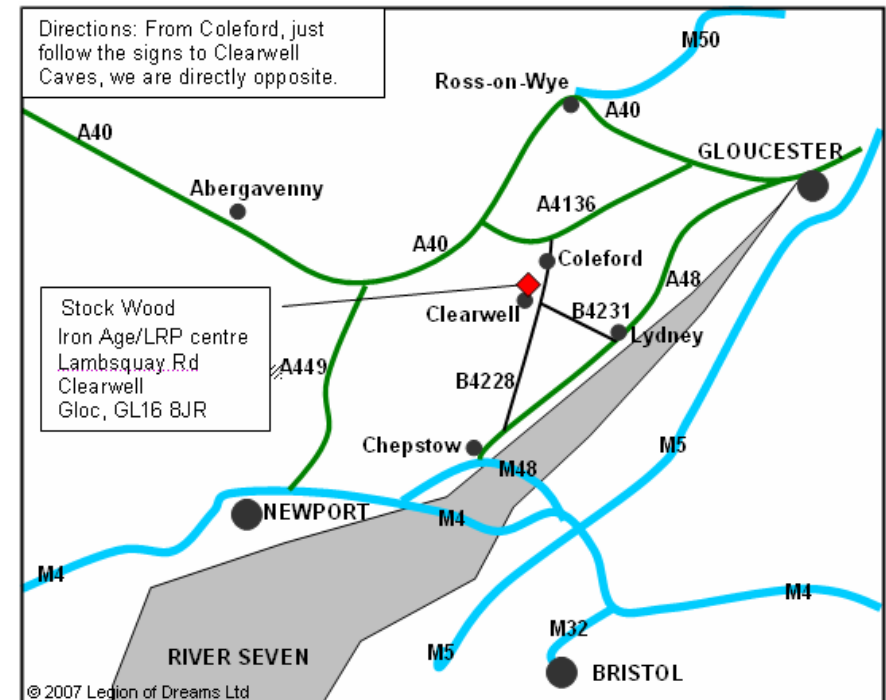
Stock Wood Live Roleplay (LRP) site



Players Information Booklet

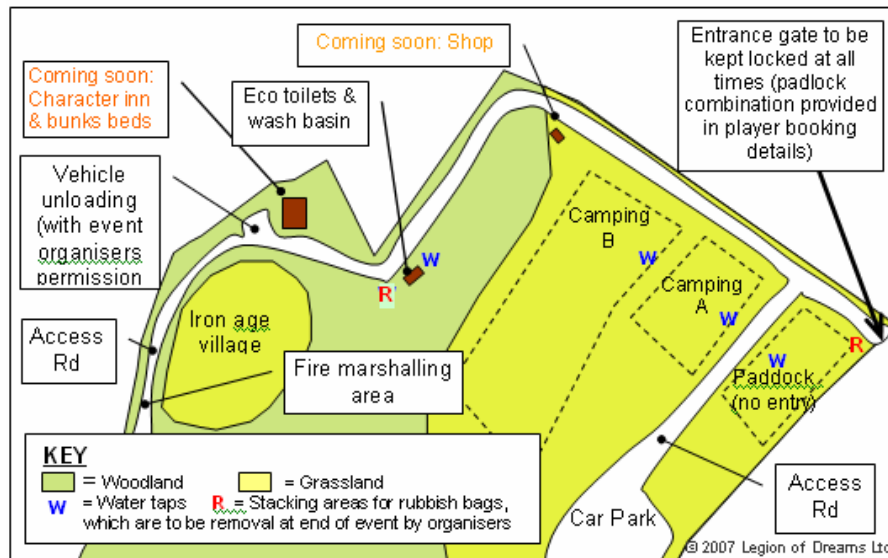
Welcome to our LRP dedicated Stock Wood site. This site is available to hire by all insured LRP groups. The site comprises of approximately 17 acres of private grassland, woodland, a network of shallow gorges, and an “in character” Iron Age village. This leaflet provides practical information generally applicable to all events run at the site.

Site Arrival

- **Access** – people participating in events are permitted on site from 15:00hrs on the Friday, until 17:00hrs on the Sunday, (unless otherwise arranged, prior to the event). Please keep the gates locked at all times, the combination for the gate padlock is “4321”
- **Parking** - on site parking is free in a car park located almost immediately to your left as you drive through the gate. The access road to the village is single track. With the permission of the event organisers on site, vehicles may be driven up to the Iron Age village for unloading/loading only. All vehicles must be return to the car park area to maintain access for emergency vehicles.
- **Camping** - there are a number of indicated camping areas on the site, with a standpipe supplying drinking water, and a

dedicated fire pit. Individual tents are not provided, but marquee and large tepees can be hired and erected for events by prior arrangement.

Site Facilities

- **3 Roundhouses** – these can sleep up to a total of about 30 people. Hay bales are generally available for use as mattresses, but a sleeping roll or bed is recommended for comfort. Small fires in the fireplaces provided are allowed in the roundhouses. These should be strictly monitored and extinguished if leaving the building. Oil/candle lanterns and covered lighting are permitted in the roundhouses, but no naked candles must be used.
- **Toilets & Washing** – An Eco-Toilet block is located on hard standing and has a wash basin with cold running water.
- **Electrics** – there is no mains electricity on site, but generators are available for hire to provide electricity for the crew and other areas if required.
- **Fire wood** - is provided in limited amounts in log piles around the village and fires are provided for cooking. To maintain a supply of wood, (with the permission of event organisers) you are encouraged to forage for “dead” wood (during daylight hours) which is plentiful in the wooded areas. Larger supplies of wood can be arranged for a small fee.
- **Disable Access** - unfortunately the wooded areas are uneven and unsuitable for access by wheelchair and other wheeled mobility devices. The Iron Age village is however accessible from the access road and one eco toilet is suitable for wheelchairs. With the permission of the event organizers disabled badge holders may park near the toilets, so long as access for emergency vehicles is maintained.

COMING SOON:

- **In character Inn** - a large 60-foot x 50-foot hut to provide a reception area, character inn, kitchen area and bunk beds.
- **LRP shop** - selling weapons, prosthetics, make-up, accessories, snacks and drink. Opening times may vary but can be prior arranged.
- **Showers & flushing toilets**

Site Safety

DANGER OF FALLING: Please be aware that there are dangerous drops and uneven ground throughout the woods on this site. You are warned to take particular care of the dangers of falling. Wire panel security fencing and natural wooden barriers have been erected to reduce the risk of falls and provide some awareness of 'drops'. While we have taken precautions to make the site as safe as possible, all users of the site do so entirely at their own risk. For your own safety:

- **DO NOT climb over or move fences or warning tape** at any time. These have been placed to warn of and protect from drops, and areas of danger.
- **DO NOT enter the woodland at night** except with good lighting and the express permission and continuous accompaniment of the event organisers.
- **DO NOT climb on the rock faces, structures or props.** This particularly applies to the roundhouse roofs, the palisade fence, etc. The only exceptions are straw bale barricades which are sometimes erected for use in skirmishes.

It is the responsibility of the individual event organisers to brief all site users on the location of the first aid kit, accident book and fire safety equipment provided on the site. The marshalling point in the event of fire is the area just to the west of the village and indicated on your map of the site. The safe use and checking of LRP weapons is also the responsibility of the individual event organisers.

General Information

Suggested kit - This is a suggested kit list for activities at Stock Wood. Certain additional items may also be appropriate, depending on the time of year, e.g. sun creams for summer, gloves and additional warm clothing for winter.

- **Strong boots with ankle support** (Trainers and shoes are NOT advised)
- **Bed roll and sleeping bag**
- **Toiletries & Towel**
- **LRP kit** (Costume, weapons, etc.)
- **Cooking utensils** (knife, fork, spoon, cup and plate)
- **Camping equipment***
- **Food for the weekend***

(* = if applicable, see specific event for details)

It is advised that valuables e.g. i-pods, jewellery, expensive cameras, watches, etc. should be left at home and not be brought to events. Organisers will not be held responsible for any items that are lost, damaged or stolen whilst on site.

Refuse and Recycling - Rubbish bins are provided on site, and there are a number of separate bins for aluminium cans, plastic and glass to assist recycling. Suitable biodegradable material can be placed in the compost bins on site. At the end of an event all rubbish is removed from site by the organisers, therefore you are asked to help in this by placing all rubbish bags just off the road either near the entrance gate or near the eco-toilets for collection.

Mobile phones – the networks of Vodafone & Orange get a good signal at the site. Most other networks receive limited or no coverage.

Animals – no dogs are allowed on the site, except for guide dogs by prior arrangement. There is a fenced paddock near the entrance gate which must not be entered or disturbed. Also be aware that

sheep sometimes roam the site, so keep the camping area gates shut to prevent their access.

No drugs except prescription or 'counter' types are permitted on site.

Conditions of Use

Stock Wood is private land and individuals are only permitted to enter the site for Live Role Play if they are aware of and agree to the following:

- Uneven ground and drops make falls a real danger and the site is used entirely at your own risk.
- Vehicles are parked & possessions brought at owner's risk.
- No excessive noise after 00:00hrs
- Legion of Dreams Ltd and in turn the event organisers reserve the right to exclude and remove any person from this site at our discretion.
